

## II. IMPLEMENTATION AND REQUIREMENTS

The qualified instructor herein swears and agrees that they are indeed qualified through Mississippi Minimum Standards and Training as Certified Firearms Instructors or have been certified by a nationally recognized organization that customarily offers firearms training, and as such, are capable of effectively and intelligently training individuals about proper firearm technique, usage and safe handling. A certificate shall be deposited with the Department of Public Safety illustrating recognition or certification of the instructor and the instructor must apply for recognition with the Department yearly. Moreover, said instructor herein swears and agrees that they possess the requisite legal knowledge of State and Federal Firearms laws to effectively and intelligently convey said knowledge of said laws to individuals receiving training for their conceal and carry endorsement. Specifically, the instructors are required to make available and review pertinent Mississippi guns laws with their trainees as a part of this agreement. This legal instruction shall, at a minimum, represent an one hour component of the overall course and include instruction relative to MS Code Section 45-9-101 (License to carry stun gun, concealed pistol or revolver) and MS Code Section 97-3-15 (Homicide; justifiable homicide; use of defensive force; duty to retreat).

The instructor herein swears and agrees that they will implement and instruct based on generally accepted course requirements of nationally recognized organizations that customarily offer firearms training. Moreover, the Department shall issue to instructors a protocol of minimum competency for granting of the endorsement. The instructors are encouraged to teach beyond the minimum requirements provided by the Department. The Department will require, at a minimum, an eight (8) hour course completion by the trainees in order to issue an endorsement to an individual.
